### Sundre High School Expectations and Regulations For Final Exams

1. Students not in attendance for their final and midterm exams may receive a **grade of zero**. In the case of illness, students will submit documentation from a physician.
2. Students are not permitted to talk, whisper, or communicate non-verbally during exams. Students who do so may receive a **grade of zero** on the exam.
3. **Course materials** (i.e. texts, review booklets, etc.) will be turned into the library **15-20 minutes** before the beginning of the exam. Students will be present at the exam room doors 10 minutes prior to the scheduled starting time.
4. **Grade 10-11 students** will stay in the exam room for a minimum of 60 minutes. **Grade 9 and 12 students** will stay in the examination room for the minimum required amount of time as determined by Alberta Education.
5. Students may bring tissues and bottled water if they desire. Students may not bring other food/drink, headphones, games, cell phones or any electronic devices other than calculators.
6. If students require food during the exam for medical reasons please see Mr. Drent before the start of the exam.
7. Students may leave the school or go to the study hall (library or lunch room) when they have completed an exam. Students are **not permitted to stay in the hallways** while exams are being written.
8. Last day of regular classes for students is **Monday, January 23**.
9. **Please report any exam conflicts to Administration by Tuesday, January 10th.**
10. Report cards will be mailed out on Tuesday, January 31.
11. Exams for courses not listed in this schedule will be written in class.
